Annual meetings « not to be missed! »

Aside from classic film releases, true cinema lovers will not miss the **Night of the Fantastic**, organized by *the New Caledonian sci-fi club* at the Noumea cinema. A thirteen-hour marathon that attracts 700 people. Independent films and cinema lovers will rejoice at the **La Foa Film Festival**. Created in 1998, it presents each year a selection of international feature films, while putting in competition **local productions: short films and Caledonian clips**. It encourages local film directors, who often start their careers with these competitions.

The cameras are also rolling on Caledonian soil, with local productions such as **The Rob Mission**, a fictional comedy released on February 19th which features two Caledonian astronauts, one Kanak, the other Caldoche, who try to embody living together in a highly sensitive context as well as the **series "OPJ, Pacifique Sud"** by **France Télévisions**, which was filmed from April to June 2019.



The MK2 Multiplex, an exceptional multimedia space will be launched at the end of 2021 in Dumbéa. It will have **14 rooms**, a total of **1,850 seats**, equipped with very large **wall-to-wall screens**, **perfect soundproofing**, **4K digital projectors** and **'7.1 Dolby sound system'**. Moreover, two rooms dedicated to alternative programming are also planned. A real meeting point complementing the cultural life of New Caledonia!
